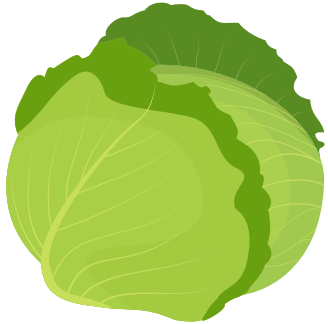

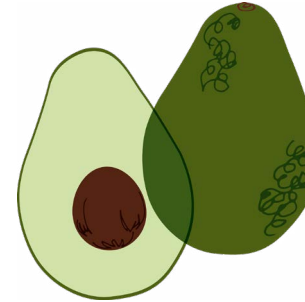

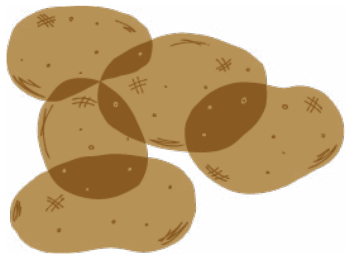
Cabbage **ALERT** ⚠️

We're currently waiting for the next round of UK and Spanish Savoy cabbage to be harvested. Quality is good but volumes are tight and there are some sights of insects present. We're working with our suppliers to ensure that quality is to specification.



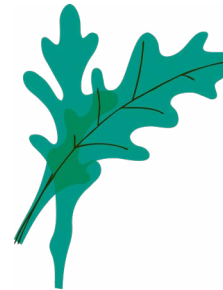
Avocado **ALERT** ⚠️

Vessel delays in South Africa is having an impact on imported Avocado volumes, which is affecting the quality and age of the product arriving the UK. Supply is starting to recover and the new season crop will alleviate any shortages. We're currently using multiple countries of origin to maintain a good quality and supply.



Potatoes (Bakers) **ALERT** ⚠️

As we come to the end of the 2018/19 stored product we're seeing some quality issues with skin discolouration, minor scabbing and unset skins. Supply is not affected and we are moving to new season bakers this week.



Wild Roquette **ALERT** ⚠️

UK wild roquette crop is currently of poor quality, due to weather damage. We have moved over to the Italian crop to maintain supply, which is of very good quality.



Blueberries

New season Polish blueberries are of good size, firm and of great eating quality.



Chillies

Moroccan and Spanish Chillies are of excellent quality and availability. We expect to see some UK product coming through soon as well.
